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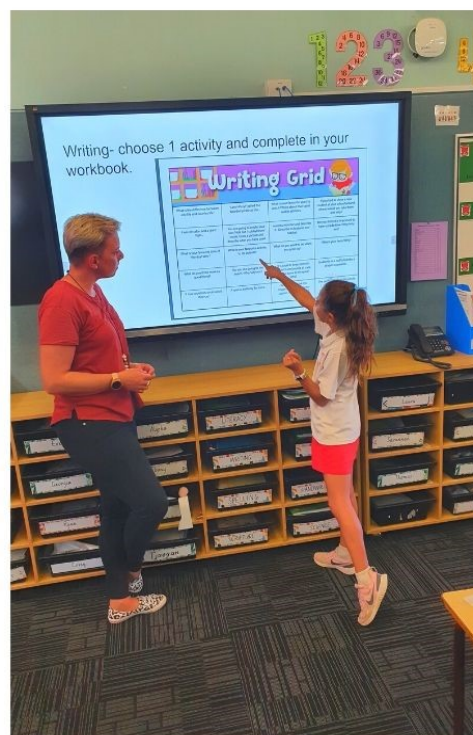

Hi to all parents, carers and staff and welcome back to school!

Please allow me to introduce myself. My name is Karen Luckel and I am the new Canteen Manager at Edward Public School. I have been working alongside Sarah over the past few months to learn the ropes. I have one son at the school, Mitchell, in year 4. I also have a daughter who is in year 8 and attending Yanco Agricultural High School. My family moved to the area almost a year ago, relocating from a farm near Tamworth to be closer to our daughter's school.

This term there are inevitably a few changes to the canteen due to Covid 19 and social distancing rules. As such, the decision has been made to open the canteen on a Friday only at this stage. Canteen will be available for both recess and lunch, with orders for both recess and lunch to be written on paper bags and placed in the mailboxes in the school office. I ask that you include details of salads, sauces etcetera required. All menu items are available for both recess and lunch, except for frozen snacks which will only be sold via order or over the counter at lunch time.

Just to rehash, the canteen will only be open for over the counter sales for frozen snacks at lunch time. At this stage there will be no over the counter ordering for recess, as has been the case in the past. I am happy to keep a book, as has been done in the past, if parents, carers and teachers find it easier to order this way. Therefore, if your child is in credit on the book, please submit your paper bag orders at the office, or please include cash if you have no credit available or wish to pay by cash each time. All orders are to be in by 9am on Friday please.

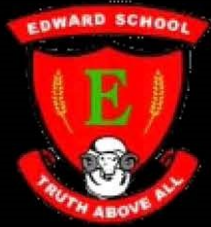
