#### Principal's Update

Dear Parents and Carers,

Welcome back to Term 3. I hope everyone managed to have a relaxing break. I am sure all the students are ready to get back to school, see their friends and start learning this term.

#### Covid Advice for Schools for Term 3

Schools will be open to welcome students back to onsite learning from the beginning of Term 3 on Tuesday 21 July.

School staff and students are reminded to practise good hand hygiene and physical distancing.

The NSW Government closed the border with Victoria from 12:01am on Wednesday 8 July 2020. All staff and students returning from Victoria after this time must have a permit to enter NSW and are required to self-isolate for a period of 14 days.

All students who have been in Victoria in the last 14 days before the commencement of school must not attend school until they complete the 14 days self-isolation period since they left Victoria.

NSW Health has requested anyone who has been in Victoria and is unwell or has flu-like symptoms arrange to be tested through their local medical practitioner or one of the COVID-19 clinics.

Details of the current advice for people who have recently visited Victoria can be found on the NSW Health border restrictions website at www.nsw.gov.au

Students who are unable to return to school due to the border closures or self-isolation will be supported to learn remotely.

We would like to remind our community the most important action you can take is to practise good hand hygiene and physical distancing. Our schools will be vigilant in implementing these requirements to minimise the risk at school.

"Learning together reinforces the role of our schools as the cornerstone of the community. We all worked together to move learning online almost overnight to maintain the continuity of education during the COVID-19 restrictions."

Education Week is an annual state-wide celebration of public education, which has been held for more than 50 years. This year's eventswill run from Monday 3 August to Friday 7 August, with a focus on opportunities to celebrate virtually.
